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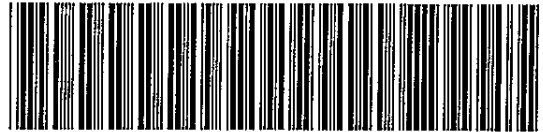

Articles of Incorporation
Of

Article 1

The name of the corporation is West St. Mark Baptist Church, Inc.

Article 2.

The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is 1435 West State Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32209.

Article 3.

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized are:

The purpose of which the organization call West St. Mark Baptist Church, Inc. is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

The purpose also shall be to cultivate, promote, promulgate and extend the teachings and percepts of Jesus Christ. In addition, to maintain a Biblical Christian Church, providing a place to worship, establishing other churches in other cities, states and international locations. Further, it shall be our purpose to establish, maintain and conduct schools for the religious instruction of the young. We will also perform other charitable works as: drug rehabilitation counseling, feeding the needy, programs for the elderly, and destitute and distressed men, women and children. Our purposes are available to all races, creeds, and sexes.

Article 4.

Article 6.


Dissolution of Organization. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized exclusively for such purposes.
