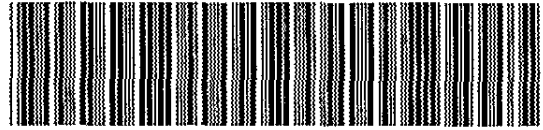

SECOND: The articles of incorporation were filed on January 21, 2003


THIRD: The corporation has not commenced to conduct its affairs.
