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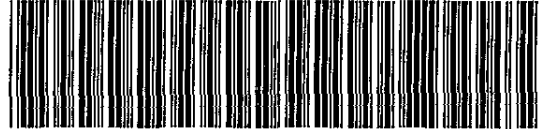

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this nonprofit corporation shall be:

" Monte Sinaí " Presbyterian Church U.S.A. Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office will be located in the city of Apopka, Orange County, in the Central Region of the State of Florida. The mailing shall be P.O. Box 161091, Altamonte Springs, Florida, 32716.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

1. To disseminate the Gospel of Jesus Christ and The Word of God, to the end that the people of God may be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ.
2. To assume our share of responsibility and the privilege of propagating the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all people regardless of race, social position, ethnic origin, religious and political affiliation.

ARTICLE IV GENERAL OBJECTIVES

1. To pray for the need of all men and for the local and national leaders and governments.
2. To provide basic New Testament discipleship to the members of the Church.
3. To deal with family and marital problems so that the home life of each Apopka members community and the Church members are healthy and fruitful by Biblical standards.

ARTICLE V MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed: Annual Meeting.

The Assembly will elect the members of the Board Of Directors. The government of this church is representative, and the right of God's people to elect their officers is inalienable. Therefore, no person can be placed in any permanent office in a congregation or governing body of the church except by election of that body.

ARTICLE IX CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP

The congregation shall welcome all persons who responding in trust and obedience to God's grace in Jesus Christ and desire to become part of membership and ministry of his Church. No person shall be denied membership because of race, ethnic origin, worldly condition, or any other reason related to profession of faith.

ARTICLE X TERM

This corporation shall exist perpetually or until dissolved by the due process of law. Should this corporation ceases to exist as a legal entity and its charter be terminated, Title to all the property automatically shall become vested as follow: Upon the dissolution the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue code. Or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Or shall be distributed to The Federal, State or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by court of common pleas; of the county in witch the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose.

ARTICLE XI AMENDMENTS

The Bylaws can be amended only by the affirmative vote of two third of the members present in a duly convened and constituted Assembly.
