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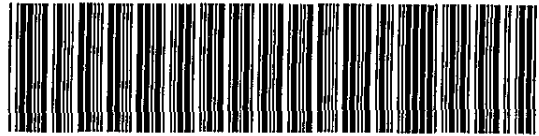

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
MANAV MANDIR, INC.

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SECRETARY OF STATE
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I - Name

The name of the corporation ("Corporation") shall be **MANAV MANDIR, INC.** and its principal place of business shall be 2290 West Eau Gallie Blvd., Suite 200, Melbourne, FL 32935. The Corporation's mailing address shall be 2290 West Eau Gallie Blvd., Suite 200, Melbourne, FL 32935.

Article II - Duration

The Corporation shall exist perpetually. The date of commencement of corporate existence shall be the date these articles are filed with the Secretary of State.

Article III - Purpose

The corporation is organized as a church or temple, for the purpose of promoting the practice of Hindu and Hindu-based religion, and supporting the study and observance of the Hindu religion; providing facilities for Hindu religious and cultural activities; and other related educational and cultural activities. However, in no event shall the Corporation engage in any activity which would not qualify as serving religious, and related charitable or educational, purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code as now in force or hereafter amended.

Article IV - Manner of Election of Directors

Directors shall be elected in the manner provided in the Corporation's Bylaws. The Directors shall also be referred to as "Trustees", and the Board of Directors shall also be referred to as the "Board of Trustees".

Article V - Powers

The Corporation shall have all powers granted to not for profit corporations in Florida, necessary and convenient to the purposes of the Corporation; subject to the limitation, however, that

the Corporation shall not have or exercise any power which would cause it to be disqualified as a tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code as now in force or hereafter amended.

Article VI - Registered Office and Initial Registered Agent

The street address of the registered office of this corporation is 1970 Michigan Avenue, Suite C, Cocoa, Florida 32923.

The name of the initial registered agent of the Corporation at that address is John L. Soileau.

Article VII Initial Board of Directors

This corporation shall have five directors initially. The number of directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time pursuant to the Bylaws, but shall never be less than three.

Article VIII - Incorporator

The name and address of the person signing these Articles is Mahesh Soni MD, 2290 West Eau Gallie Blvd., Suite 200, Melbourne, Florida 32935.

Article IX - Bylaws

The power to adopt the Bylaws of the Corporation shall be vested in the Board of Directors. Thereafter, the Bylaws may be altered, amended, or repealed as provided therein.

Article X - Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Corporation as determined by the Board of Directors, its remaining assets, if any, shall be distributed to one or more organizations chartered and operated exclusively for religious, charitable or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code as now in force or hereafter amended.

Article XI - Amendment

The Corporation, through majority vote of the Board of Directors, reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation.

Article XIII - Acceptance of Registered Agent

Having been named to accept service of process for the Corporation, at the place designated in these Articles of Incorporation, I hereby accept to act in this capacity and agree to comply with the provisions of the Florida Statutes relative to keeping open said office.
