Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Iaw), or (b) by an organization contributions to which are deductible under section 170 € (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Iaw).
 - 4. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to section 501 \$\preceq\$(3) exempt purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever mure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.
 - 5. Upon the dissolution and winding up of the corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprotitifund, foundation, association, or corporation organized and operated exclusively for the purposes specified in section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and which has established its tax-exempt status under that section.
