### Article III - Purpose

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, but not limited to such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. See also addendum A-B-C of Article III.

Article 16 - Dissolution

### DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section  $501 \, \mathbb{C}$  (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. None of its assets, real, personal or mixed property shall be distributed to its Officers or Members.
