PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1406, Florida Statutes, this document is a Plan of Distribution of Assets ("Plan of Distribution") to be followed by The Judge Alva Carver Foundation, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation (the "Corporation"), upon its dissolution (the "Proposed Dissolution"). The Plan of Distribution is as follows:

- 1. All liabilities and obligations of the Corporation shall be paid and discharged, or adequate provisions shall be made therefor.
- 2. All assets held by the Corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the Proposed Dissolution, shall be returned, transferred, or conveyed in accordance with such requirements.
- 3. All assets held by the Corporation subject to limitations permitting their use only for charitable, religious, eleemosynary, benevolent, educational, or similar purposes, but not held upon a condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance by reason of the Proposed Dissolution, shall be transferred or conveyed to one or more domestic or foreign corporations, trusts, societies, or organizations engaged in activities substantially similar to those of the Corporation, as provided in this Plan of Distribution.
- 4. All other assets, if any, shall be distributed in accordance with the provisions of the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws, to the extent the Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws provide for distribution to others.
- 5. Any remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to such persons, trusts, societies, organizations, or domestic or foreign corporations, whether for profit or not for profit, as specified in this Plan of Distribution.

The effective date of the Proposed Dissolution, if approved and adopted, shall be May 16, 2017.
