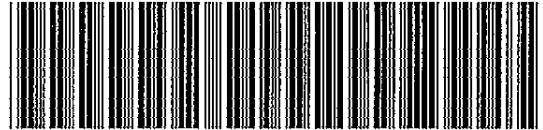

ARTICLE I NAME

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

To provide array of services in exercising maximum independence in activities of daily living, communication skills and recreation opportunity to mentally and physically challenge children, youth and families, to include; twenty-four hours a day assisting living facility, respite care and enhance quality of life by promoting self-sufficiency. This organization is exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of Section 501 c (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States of Internal Revenue Law. This organization is a not-for-profit Corporation for charitable purposes.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes, and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501 c (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
