Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments(s) adopted: (INDICATE ARTICLE NUMBER(S) BEING AMENDED, ADDED OR DELETED)

The following wordage is added to the original Articles as an addition to the articles.

Articles VIII

Articles of Incorporation of the under-signed, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Florida, do hereby certify:

The name of the Corporation shall be "INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR ART & CULTURE OF PALM BEACH COUNTY INC.

Articles IX

The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is the City of Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, USA.

Articles X

The said corporation is organized ex-clusively for charitable, religious educational, purposes of teaching performing arts of multi cultures of various origins regardless of the source, age, gender including, for such purposes, the

making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c), (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The purpose of the organization also includes to receive contributions and pay them over to organizations that are described in section 501(c) (3) and exempt from taxation under section 501(a).

Articles XI

The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial trustees/directors of the corporation are as follows:

Articles XII

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article VIII hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. If reference to federal law in articles of incorporation imposes a limitation that is invalid in the State of Florida, then the following substitute for the last sentence of the preceding paragraph: "Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation."

Articles XIII

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
