

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF N.O.R.M.A FOR LATINOS! INC.

The undersigned incorporator, a natural person 18 years of age or older, in order to form a corporate entity adopts the following articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I NAME/REGISTERED OFFICE

The name of this corporation shall be N.O.R.M.A For Latinos! INC.

The acronym N.O.R.M.A stands for Non-Stop, Organizing, Recruiting, Mentoring & Advocating For Latinos! INC. The Registered Agent is Norma Iris Lopez located in Putnam County, 104 Park Road, Interlachen, Florida 32148. I hereby am familiar with and accept the duties and responsibilities of

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific, social/community organizing, Advocating, educational and empowerment towards self-sufficiency purposes, more specifically to advocating, community organizing and empowering Hispanics towards self-sufficiency. To this end, the corporation shall at all times be operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift, grants, contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes.

ARTICLE III EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS

At all times shall the following operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

PART A

- The corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise to
 its members. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the
 benefit of any member of the corporation, except that reasonable compensation
 may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or
 more of its purposes. Such net earnings, if any, of this corporation shall be
 used to carry out the nonprofit corporate purposes set forth in Article II
 above.
- 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
- 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.

PART B

In furtherance, but not in limitation, of the foregoing charitable, educational and scientific purposes, N.O.R.M.A. For Latinos! INC. shall have the following powers:

- Engage in innovative, any and all activities that will directly or indirectly improve or benefit the lives, social or economic condition of the Hispanic community in Putnam County.
- 2. To hire and terminate employment services of employees and contract consultants for outside services at the will of the corporation.
- 3. To exercise all rights and powers conferred upon corporations formed under the general nonprofit corporation law of the state of Florida, provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any activities or exercise any powers, including those specifically mentioned herein, that are not in furtherance of the specific and primarily charitable, educational and scientific purposes of the corporation.
- The operation of said corporation shall also include the concerns of: □ Language barriers □ Entertainment Economic development; minority non-profit start up counseling/mentoring Literacy as it relates to basic English and communication skills Professional development Community organizing Transportation □ Parenting education ☐ Furthering education counseling ☐ Food, shelter and clothing assistance □ Child/Elder abuse and neglect □ Disability advocacy services □ Domestic violence Single parents □ Minority representation and inclusion Nutrition and health ☐ Health disparities
- Point of distribution, counseling and action planning for homeland security incase of terrorist attack or natural disaster.
 All of the above mentioned purposes and powers shall be exercised exclusively for charitable and
- 5. All of the above mentioned purposes and powers shall be exercised exclusively for charitable and educational purposes in such manner to be compliant and qualified as an exempt organization under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.

ARTICLE IV DURATION

The duration of the corporate existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V MEMBERSHIP/BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Updated resource and referral system

The corporation shall have no members. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in the corporation's bylaws. No Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the corporation.

Members of the first Board of Directors shall serve until the first annual meeting, at which their successors are duly elected and qualified, or removed as provided in the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI PERSONAL LIABILITY

No employee, officer, or Director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the employee, officer, or Directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII DISSOLUTION

At the time of dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all debts, obligations, liabilities, costs and expenses of the corporation, distribute all of the assets of the corporation. In non-case shall a disposition be made which would not qualify as a charitable contribution under Section 170(c)(1) or (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, in such manner as the Board of Directors shall determine.
