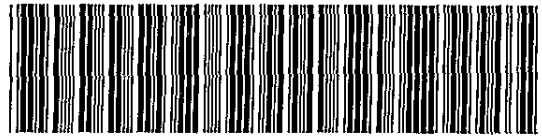

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is INTER-ANGELS FOUNDATION

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal office and mailing address of the corporation is c/o Post Office Box 25712, Tampa, Florida 33622.

ARTICLE III - STATEMENT OF CORPORATE NATURE

This is a non-profit corporation organized to engage in any lawful act or activities that are for charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and pursuant to the Florida Corporation Not-For-Profit law set forth in Part 1 of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes. The specific purpose of this foundation is to provide charitable and humanitarian support to the indigenous indians living in the country of Panama and the neighboring countries including relief through education, food, clothing and medical supplies.

ARTICLE IV - DURATION

The corporation is to have perpetual existence commencing on the date of this filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State.

ARTICLE V - INCORPORATOR

ARTICLE VI - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is formed without any purpose of pecuniary profit and shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE VII - MEMBERSHIP

The only members of this organization shall be its Board of Directors. The qualification for members and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the By-Laws of the corporation.

**ARTICLE VIII - MANAGEMENT**

Subject to the provisions of the laws of the State of Florida, the following provisions are adopted for the management of the business and for the conduct of the affairs of the Corporation, and for defining, limiting and regulating the powers of the corporation and the directors:

(a) The business of the corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors; and the Board of Directors shall have the power to exercise all policy making powers of the Corporation, including but not limited to the power to create mortgages upon the whole or any part of the property of the corporation, real or personal, except as otherwise provided by statute or by the By-Laws of the corporation.

(b) An increase in the number of directors shall be deemed to create a vacancy or vacancies in the Board of Directors, to be filled in the manner provided in the By-Laws. Any director or officer elected or appointed by the Board of Directors may be removed at any time, in such a manner as shall be provided in the By-Laws. There shall be a minimum of three (3) directors at all times in this corporation on its Board of Directors.

(c) The Board of Directors shall have the power to make and alter the By-Laws of the corporation, subject to such restrictions upon the exercise of such power as may be imposed by the By-Laws adopted by them from time to time.

**ARTICLE IX - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT**

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is: 6406 North 20th Street, Tampa, Florida 33610 and the name of the registered agent of this corporation at that address is Marilyn Gengler.

**ARTICLE X - INDEMNIFICATION**

This corporation shall indemnify any officer or director or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

**ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENTS**

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, add to or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation by a majority vote of the Board of Directors and in the manner now
