To: STATE CORPORATION COMMISSION:

The undersigned natural person of the age of twenty-one or more, acting as incorporator, adopts the following Articles of Incorporator pursuant to the State Nonstock Corporation Act:

FIRST:

The name of the corporation is Osceola County Abstinence Project, INC.

SECOND:

The period of duration is perpetual.

THIRD:

The corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. (All references of sections in this Articles refer to the Internal Revenue code of 1986 as amended or to comparable sections of subsequent internal revenue laws.) Specifically, the corporation is organized to provide abstinence education to teens and pre-teens in our community, as well as providing safe and healthy after-school programming where teens can learn about the value of postponing sexual involvement until marriage. It is also our intent to reach out to parents to provide them with information and support as they attempt to deal with the difficult adolescent years. In pursuit of these purposes it shall have the powers to carry on any business or other activity which may be lawfully conducted by a corporation organized under the Florida Nonstock Corporations Act, whether or not related to the foregoing purposes, and to do all things necessary, proper and consistent with maintaining tax exempt status under section 501©(3).

FOURTH:

The corporation will not have any members.

FIFTH:

The registered agent is Sandi Miller, who is a resident of the state of Florida and a director of the corporation, and the address of its initial registered office is 27 East 13th Street St. Cloud, Florida 34769, which is physically located in the county of Osceola.

SIXTH:

No substantial amount of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and this corporation shall not intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles or of any Bylaws adopted thereunder, this corporation shall not take any action not permitted by the laws which then apply to this corporation.
