

ADOPTED AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF WEST BAY VILLAGE TOWNHOMES ASSOCIATION, INC.

1. Adopted amendment to ARTICLE VI of the Articles, as follows:

ARTICLE VI VOTING RIGHTS

The Association shall have two classes of voting membership:

Class A. Class A The members shall be all Owners, with the exception of the Declarant (as defined in the Declaration), and shall be entitled to one vote for each Lot owned. When more than one person holds an interest in any Lot, all such persons shall be members. The vote for such Lot shall be exercised as they determine, but in no event shall more than one vote be cast with respect to any Lot.

- Class B. The Class B member shall-be the Declarant, and shall-be entitled to nine (9) votes for each lot owned. The Class B membership shall cease and be converted to Class A membership on the happening of the following events, whichever occurs earlier:
- —— (b) on the anniversary date five years from the date when the first Lot is conveyed to an individual purchaser.
- 2. Adopted amendment to Article VII, Section 1., of the Articles, as follows:

ARTICLE VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. This Association's affairs are managed by a Board of Directors initially composed of three Directors. The number of Directors from time to time may be changed by amendment to this as provided for in the Association's By-Laws, but at all times it must be an odd number of three or more but not to exceed five (5). . . . Cumulative voting is not permitted. Directors need not must be Association members.

3. Adopted amendment to ARTICLE XI of the Articles, as follows:

ARTICLE XI BY-LAWS

This Association's By-Laws initially will be adopted by the Board of Directors. Thereafter, the By-Laws may be altered, amended, or rescinded as

provided for in the By-Lawswith the approval of a majority of each class of members, except as to those provisions for Amendment to the By-Laws-which are provided in the Declaration or any Supplemental Declaration in which case those provisions shall control such Amendments.
