THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as sole incorporator of LADY CYCLE RIDERS, INC., a not for profit corporation under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I NAME
