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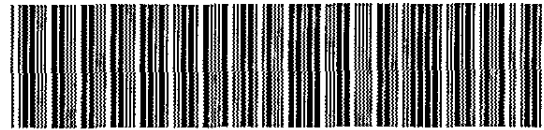

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S. (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

To associate in one united, compact body of men of Confederate ancestry, and to cultivate, perpetuate & sanctify the ties of fraternity and friendship entailed thereby; to aid and encourage the history and achievement from Jamestown to this present era, constantly endeavoring to see that the events of the War Between the States and its heroic contributions of the Confederate soldiers and those of Indian Territory are authentically and clearly written, and that all documents, relics and mementos produced and handed down by those active participants therein are properly treasured and preserved for posterity; to aid and assist in the erection of suitable and enduring monuments and memorials to all Southern valor, civil and military wherever done and wherever found to instill into our descendants a devotion to and reverence for the principles represented by the Confederate States of America, to the honor, glory, and memory of our fathers who fought in that cause.

To support and defend the Constitution of the United States of America, largely written by Southerners, as the Magna Charta of our liberties.

To preserve our Southern heritage and the memory of our heroic Confederate ancestors, who by their sacrifice perpetuated that heritage of valor, honor and patriotism which we now hold and venerate.

To diligently seek to increase the membership of Camp 1315 and support membership recruiting efforts in all existing Camps of Sons of Confederate Veterans.

To diligently support efforts to establish Camps of the Sons of Confederate Veterans in cities and towns and locations where such Camps are not presently operating.

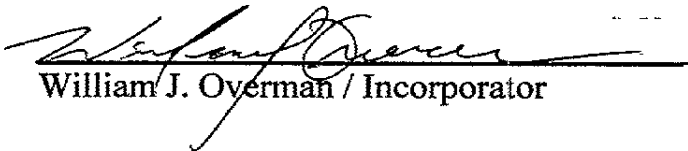
