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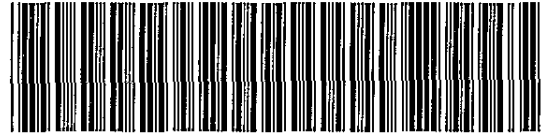

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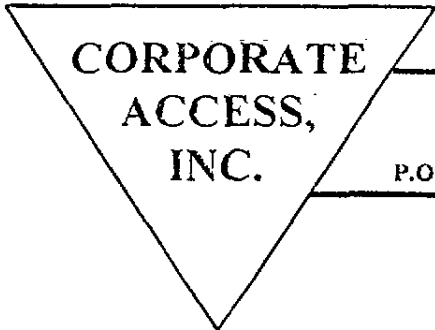

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
OF

IGBO YOUTH CLUB OF FLORIDA, INC.

A FLORIDA NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a not-for-profit corporation under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act, as set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, as amended, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE 1: NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be: IGBO YOUTH CLUB OF FLORIDA, INC., hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation".

ARTICLE 2: PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The address of the principal office of the Corporation and the mailing address are: 7625 CORAL BLVD, MIRAMAR, FLORIDA 33023.

ARTICLE 3: DURATION

The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE 4: PURPOSES

The Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, Cultural and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. To promote the culture, welfare, economy and health of the people in our community and the Diaspora; while also (1) Educating interested person in all aspect of Igbo culture. (2) Promoting interaction between the people of the United States of America and Igbos in particular and Nigeria as a whole. (3) Fortifying the identity and self confidence of our youth through social, civic and Igbo language instructions and other activities.

ARTICLE 5: RESTRICTION ON ACTIVITIES

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall this corporation participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE 6 REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The Corporation's initial registered agent and street address is Richard Nzeribe, 160 NW 176 Street, Suite #200-4, Miami, Florida 33169.

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ARTICLE 7: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall be elected by secret ballot. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by an amendment to the bylaws. All directors shall be selected as provided for in the bylaws.

ARTICLE 8: OFFICERS

The officers of the Corporation shall be (a) The Chairman; (b) General Secretary; (c) Assistant General Secretary; (d) Public Relation Officer; (e) Financial Secretary; (f) Treasurer; (g) Provost; and such other officers as may be provided by the bylaws or deemed necessary by the Board of Directors.

The interim officers consists of the following:

Chairman: Kavin Okoli King.
Secretary: Paul Okeke
Financial Secretary: Christian Umeh.

ARTICLE 9: DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes and which has established its tax exempt under Section 501(c) (3) of the internal Revenue Code.
