### ARTICLE III PURPOSE

Joel Thornton Foundation has the mission of educating elementary, middle and high school students across the United States by beautifying their schools. Lessons in flora and fauna, composition and design, landscaping and architecture will accompany the actual renewal of a school's exterior and surroundings. In an addition, the Foundation will assume infrastructure tasks that will lessen the burdens of government. The Foundation will acquire grants and other monies for the purpose of hiring students and faculty of Landscape Architecture colleges to design and supervise the mission tasks. Students, faculty and parents will assist in completing each school's master plan. After completion, the school will have landscape architecture added to its curriculum for continued education and provide for maintenance.

### Further stipulations are:

- a. Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, thee making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c (3) of the Internal Revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- b. No part of the net earning of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an
  - organization, contribution to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- c. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purpose within the meaning of section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
