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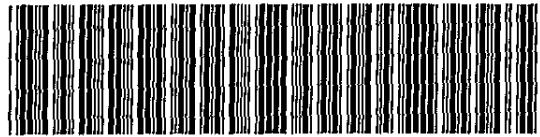

**Articles of Incorporation
of
Emmaus Baptist Church of Safety Harbor, Inc.**

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SECRETARY OF STATE
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned, acting as the incorporators of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article 1

The name of the corporation is EMMAUS BAPTIST CHURCH OF SAFETY HARBOR, INC.

Article 2

The principal place of business of this corporation is 605 Second Street North, Safety Harbor, FL 34695 (Pinellas County). Mailing address: P. O. Box 275, Safety Harbor, Florida 34695-0275.

Article 3

The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), including, but not limited to, for such purposes, the establishing and maintaining of religious worship, the evangelizing of the unsaved by proclaiming of the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, the educating of believers in a manner consistent with the requirements of Holy Scripture, the maintaining of missionary activities in the United States and any foreign country.

Article 4

The method of election of directors shall be stated in the Bylaws of the corporation. The corporation shall have a minimum of three (3) directors.

Article 5

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, employees, or other private person, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the tax-exempt purposes of the corporation set for in Article 3.

Article 6

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an organization exempt from Federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article 7

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Article 8

The corporation shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin and shall be racially nondiscriminatory in the administration of all of its policies and programs.

Article 9

The qualifications, rights, privileges, duties, and classifications of members of the corporation shall be stated in the Bylaws of the corporation.

Article 10

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 605 Second Street North, Safety Harbor, Florida 34695-0275 and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at the initial registered office is Robert Delnay.

Article 11

The name of incorporators of the corporation are: Robert Delnay, 2968 Compton Court, Clearwater, Florida 33761 and Roger Bradley, 165 Joyce Street, Safety Harbor, Florida 34695-2221.

Article 12

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, except that the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article 13

The period of the duration of the corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law.
