ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE 1 ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Incorporates business name, place of business, Bylaws, Seals and fiscal year.

ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP CLASSES

Establishes the classes of nonvoting membership.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The Corporation shall be a nonprofit organization formed and operated exclusively for charitable, educational and religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code).

ARTICLE IV DIRECTORS

This Article provides all aspects involving Directors, from duties, number of directors and tenure, meetings, committees, compensation, interest of a director in transactions, to any other items related to Directors.

ARTICLE V OFFICERS

This Article provides all aspects involving Officers, from duties, elections, meetings, committees, compensation, corporate instruments, to any other items related to Officers.

ARTICLE VI AMENDMENTS

The Board shall have the power to alter, amend, or repeal the Bylaws or adopt new Bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII POWERS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. ARTICLE IX DISSOLUTIONS OF SCHOOL

In addition to that wording, the following statement will be added: If Wakulla Christian School becomes defunct, by law, all permanent information and student records would be immediately turned over to the Wakulla County public school district.

ARTICLE X NON-DISCRIMINATORY STATEMENT

Wakulla Christian School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, or ethnicity in its hiring practices of staff or admissions of students. WCS admits students of any race, color or ethnicity to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at this school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, or ethnicity in the administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, and scholarship, athletic and other school administered programs. Hiring practices consider education, certifications, experience, and information from former employers, background checks, Christian testimony and salvation.

ARTICLE XI BOOKS

Pertains to keeping books, records, and minutes for the Board and committees as well as inspections of said items.

ARTICLE XII INDEMNIFICATION

Pertains to the standard of conduct and the indemnification of those serving as Directors, Officers, or agents against expenses (including attorneys' fees), judgments, fines, penalties, and amounts paid in settlements.
