ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FLORIDA, INC.

SLUNCIARY OF STATE

The subscribers and undersigned incorporator all being HARSEFULLORIDA ages have associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit, without capital stock under the provisions of pertinent Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I- NAME

The name of the corporation is: FILIPINO AMERICAN COALITION OF FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE II- NATURE AND PURPOSES

The corporation is a coalition of Filipino American leaders and advocates of Filipino American causes.

The purposes are:

- 1. To serve as networking mechanism of Filipino American leaders and advocates of Filipino American causes.
- 2. To provide fora for leaders to identify common issues and concerns in the State level, and formulate recommendations to address identified issues to various Filipino American organizations.
- 3. To conduct other activities in pursuance of and incidental to the accomplishment of the above stated objectives.

### ARTICLE III-MEMBERSHIP

Any person who holds a leadership position or role in any Filipino American organization or advocacy groups that promote Filipino American causes shall be eligible for membership in this corporation upon application to and approval as provided in the by-laws.

Membership may be terminated by expulsion for a just cause or by resignation with thirty (30) days prior written notice of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IV-DURATION

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

## ARTICLE- V- MANAGEMENT

Section 1: The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than three and not more than nine persons. Directors shall be elected or removed in accordance with the procedure provided in the by-laws.

Section 2: The officers shall be the Chairperson who shall act as the convenor, the Vice Chairperson who shall act as the Executive Director, and Secretary-Treasurer. These officers shall be elected and shall hold office in the manner provided in the bylaws of the corporation.

### ARTICLE VI-INITIAL OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

### ARTICLE VII- BYLAWS AND AMENDMENTS

The Bylaws of the corporation shall be made, altered or rescinded by a majority vote of the voting membership present or voting by proxy at any regular meeting, or by a majority vote of the Board of Directors; provided that notice thereof, which shall include the test of the bylaws change, has been furnished in writing to each voting member of the corporation at least ten days to the meeting at which such alteration to the bylaws is to be voted upon whether it be a membership meeting or a Board of Directors meeting.

Amendments of additional provisions of the Articles of Incorporation shall be proposed by the Board of Directors and added or adopted by a two thirds vote of the voting membership present or voting by proxy at any regular or special meeting.

### ARTICLE VIII- GENERAL PROVISION

All income or assets of the corporation, above necessary expenses

shall be administered solely and exclusively for the corporate selected by the Board of Directors.

This corporation shall have no capital stock and shall pay no dividends to its incorporator, subscribers, directors, officers or members. In addition, no part of the income of the corporation shall be distributed to its members, directors, officers or incorporator.
