We see the name that you gave reference to is **VILLAGE OF HOPE, INC.**, the name of our organization is just **VILLAGE HOPE**.


After becoming aware of the problem in name we meet and voted to add, **of Pensacola, FL** to our organization name.

ONE:

The name of the corporation is **VILLAGE HOPE OF PENSACOLA, FL INC.** The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is **100 YOAKUM COURT, Pensacola, FL 32505.** The corporation is organized pursuant of the Florida, Nonprofit Corporation Code.

TWO:

This public benefit corporation is a controlled organization authorized to transact business, no one may have its name or the same name, and it can sue, borrow, and file bankruptcy and more. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. This corporation is tax-exempt and can receive tax-deductible contributions as outline in IRS Publication 557 and Application 1023. This corporation is not required to file annually tax returns for church or religious related business or public benefit organizations. This public benefit corporation shall establish and carry out business related to but, not limited to: The Creed; By-Laws; Standard Operational Procedures, Doctrine and other related public benefit activities.



THREE:

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, no stock and shall have no members.

FIVE

- a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for Educational and Charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- b) Notwithstanding any other provision of their Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to carry on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

SIX:

The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to Charitable and Educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever be useful for the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or the benefit of any private person.

SEVEN:

On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for, Educational and Charitable under Section 501 ©(3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal officer of the organization is located, exclusive for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.


EIGHT:
