ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF KINGS MILL COMMERCIAL PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION, IN

The following provisions of the Articles of Incorporation of KINGS MILL COMMERCIAL PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., a Florida not-for-profit corporation (the "Corporation"), filed with the Florida Department of State on July 16, 2003, Charter Number N03000006060, are hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE III of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is:

To provide for the preservation of the values and amenities in the KINGS MILL COMMERCIAL CENTER (including, without limitation, operating and maintaining certain common surface water management system facilities, including all common inlets, ditches, swales, culverts, water control structures, retention and detention areas, ponds, lakes, floodplain compensation areas, wetlands and any associated buffer areas, and wetland mitigation areas, if any, to the extent same is the responsibility of the Corporation pursuant to that certain Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Kings Mill Commercial Center, to be recorded in the Public Records of Hillsborough County, Florida)."

The following is hereby added as Article VIII to the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation:

"ARTICLE VIII

The Corporation may be dissolved upon the affirmative vote (in person or by proxy) or written consent or any combination thereof, of members holding not less than eighty percent (80%) of the total votes of the Corporation. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, other than incident to a merger or consolidation, the assets of the Corporation shall be dedicated to an appropriate public agency or to any non-profit corporation, association, trust, or other organization to be used for purposes similar to those for which this Corporation was created. Notwithstanding the above, the Corporation may not be dissolved unless all responsibilities of the Corporation are assumed by a responsible entity approved by members holding not less than eighty percent (80%) of the total votes of the Corporation.

In the event of termination, dissolution, or final liquidation of the Corporation, the responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the common surface water management system facilities referenced in Article III above (to the extent same is the responsibility of the Corporation) must be transferred to and

accepted by an appropriate governmental entity or public utility; and if not accepted by such governmental entity or public utility, same shall be transferred to and accepted by a not-for-profit corporation similar to the Corporation."

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being the President of the Corporation, has adopted and executed these Articles of Amendment as of the <u>3/</u> day of May, 2005.
