The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt (s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I Name of Corporation

The Name of this Corporation shall be Child Crisis Home Intervention Program Society Inc.

ARTICLE II Principle Office

The principle office of the corporation shall be 840 W. 5th Street, Riviera Beach, Florida 33404, County of Palm Beach, and any other such office or place that the Board of Directors may deem from time to time as per space and facilities needed.

ARTICLE III Statement of Purpose

This organization is for charitable purposes within the Internal Revenue Statute for a not-for-profit organization. To assist those youth within the Juvenile Justice System and those youth who are at risk of entering the system or becoming a product of their immediate environment. To provide services that will enhance their ability to survive in today's society and reach their maximum potential. To assist those youth going through unpleasant situations such as abuse in all forms, neglect, teenage pregnancy/parenting which results in the need of emotional and or spiritual encouragement and ongoing mentoring or counseling. To teach entrepreneur skills, provide shelter, educational and employable skills training and placement, conduct individual and group counseling and self-esteem workshop. To provide them with the exposure and life skills training needed for today's youth to become positive influences for their piers and the younger generation after them. To offer other referrals and resources as per each youth needs.

To develop and implement innovative approaches to stimulate economic development. To enhance community development through rehabilitation of existing substandard buildings and construction of new facilities in the place of blighted structures of blighted vacant sites for the purpose of combating the deterioration of the community, contributing to its physical improvement. To provide a residence for disadvantaged youth, teenage mothers and their children who are homeless and in need of shelter and love. To allow the youth enrolled in the program to be instrumental in assisting others in their struggles.

To assist in the process of improving the lives, living conditions for each participating youth to become a respectful citizens, community leaders and economically self-reliant.

ARTICLE IV

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is:

For the first fiscal year the board members will be elected by the choice of the Founder/Chief Executive Officer, and a general vote by the appointed board members will decide thereafter.
