Articles of Incorporation for the Florida Chapter of the JALLAHASSEE FLORIDA National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc.

In compliance with the requirements of the laws of Florida, the undersigned hereby act to form a non-stock corporation not-for-profit and to that end set forth the following:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is: The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business shall be: 2621 SW Natura Avenue, Deerfield Beach, Fl 33441 and the mailing address of The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. shall be: PO Box 488, Deerfield Beach, Fl 33443.

ARTICLE III

Section 1: Purpose

The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, medical and scientific purposes, including for such purposes: encourage and support the education of Hispanic youth; train Hispanic Leaders with respect to Judeo-Christian principals; establish a clearing house for the exchange of ideas by Hispanic individuals and organizations and implement projects and programs that will assist in improving the well being of Hispanics and other minority communities as deemed necessary.

Section 2: Powers

For the accomplishment of these purposes The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. shall have all powers permitted it under the laws of Florida. Without, in any particular, limiting the generality of the foregoing: The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. shall have the power: to own, operate, print, publish, manage and distribute such publications and literature for the dissemination and exchange of information as will further the objects and purpose; to purchase, lease or otherwise acquire and hold, own, use and operate, or mortgage or otherwise encumber, or sell, real and personal property as may be necessary to carry out the objects and purposes; and to receive and maintain a fund or funds of real or personal property, or both, and subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively in the furtherance of the objects and purposes of The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc.

Section 3: Activities

No part of the net earnings of The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. shall inure to the benefit of any Director or Officer, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or from The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. in the furtherance of one or more of its Purposes, provided that no Director shall be compensated for his services as such Director).

Section 4: Dissolution

Upon dissolution of The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. or the winding up of its affairs, the assets shall be distributed exclusively to charitable, religious, scientific, literary, or educational organizations which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3), or successor section, of the Internal Revenue Code and the Regulations thereunder as they now exist or is they may hereafter be amended. No director or officer of The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. or any private individual, shall be entitled to share in the distribution or division of any of the corporate assets upon dissolution.

Section 5: Non-profit Limitations

Not withstanding any other provision of these Articles, The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501(C) (3), or successor section, of the Internal Revenue Code and the regulations thereunder as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended or by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C)(2), or successor section, of the Internal Revenue Code and the regulations thereunder as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended. Conversely, The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. shall have the power to, and shall conduct and carry on activities required to be conducted or carried on in order to acquire and maintain a determination that it is an organization exempt under Section 501(C3), or successor section, of the Internal Revenue Code and the regulations thereunder as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended. To that end, if The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. shall be a "private foundation" as the term is defined in Section 509, or successor Section, of the Internal Revenue Code and the Regulations thereunder as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended, The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner, as not to object The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. to the tax imposed under Section 4942, or successor Section, of the Internal Revenue Code, and the regulations thereunder as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended; and The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. shall not engage in any act of "self-dealing" retain any excess business holdings, invest any amount in such a manner as to "jeopardize the carrying out of any of its exempt purposes, or make any taxable expenditure" as those respective terms and phrases are defined in Section 4941(d), 4943(C), 4944 and 4945 (D), respectively, or successor sections, of the Internal Revenue Code and the Regulations thereunder as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

ARTICLE IV

The Florida Chapter of the National Organization for the Advancement of Hispanics, Inc. shall have members and the qualification for membership and Board membership shall be as provided in the Bylaws. The manner of election of the Directors of the Corporation shall be as provided in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE Y

The number of Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is three (3) and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial Directors are:
