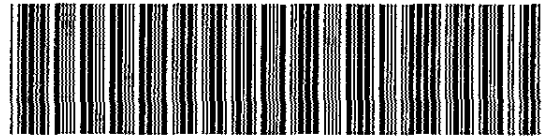
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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SOJOURNER TRUTH HIGH SCHOOL
OF HUMANITIES & TECHNOLOGY, INC.

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The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a Florida corporation not-for-profit under the Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article I

Name

The name of the corporation is Sojourner Truth High School of Humanities & Technology, Inc.

Article II

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is P.O. Box 7773, Jacksonville, FL 32238.

Article III

Specific and General Purpose

The specific and primary purpose for which this corporation is formed is to organize and carry on educational activities as a charter school under the laws of Florida section 1002.33 hereby authorized the creation of charter schools to be part of the State's public education program.

The general purpose for which this corporation is formed is to be operated exclusively for such educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt educational organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as tax exempt organizations under the Code.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles of incorporation, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws or by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

This Corporation shall be nonsectarian in programs, admissions, and policies, accountable to sponsor for student performance, may not charge tuition or fees except those normally charged by other public schools and operate non-discriminatorily, subject to annual financial audits.

Article IV

Duration

This corporation shall exist perpetually.

Article V

Membership

The members of this corporation shall consist of the Board of Directors. Directors shall be elected as according to the by-laws.

Modification of Bylaws

Subject to the limitations contained in the bylaws and any limitations set forth in the State of Florida, the bylaws of this corporation may be made, altered, rescinded, added to, or new bylaws may not modify alter, amend or restrict any part of these Articles of Incorporation.

Article IX

Distribution of Assets Upon Dissolution

When a charter is not renewed or is terminated, the school shall be dissolved under the provisions of law under which the school was organized, any unencumbered funds from the charter school shall revert to the district school board. In the event the charter school is dissolved, or is otherwise terminated, all district school board property and improvements, furnishings and equipment purchased with public funds shall automatically revert to full ownership by the district school board.

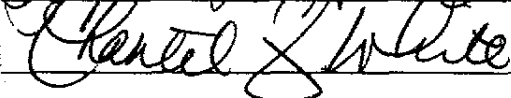

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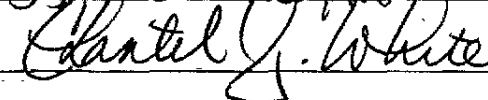
