

#### ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the following purposes:

- A. To create a greater awareness and appreciation of Public Gardens of Northwest Florida and encourage the use of public gardens to promote a better neighborhood and community.
- B. To raise funds to contribute to the University of Florida Foundation, Inc. SHARE program to provide scholarships to students of the environmental horticulture programs on the Milton Campus of the University of Florida.
- C. To expand the role of Public Gardens of Northwest Florida to foster research and provide horticultural education programs through partnerships with schools, community organizations, and the horticulture industry.
- D. To provide operational funds for implementation of research, community outreach, and educational programs of Public Gardens in Northwest Florida by soliciting gifts, bequests, grant funds, volunteer time, equipment, materials, services, and art.
