We, the undersigned, in compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., do hereby join and associate ourselves together for the purpose of creating and becoming a corporation, non-profit in nature and purpose, in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, and do jointly and severally subscribe to these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation shall be SAINT JOHN'S ORTHODOX CATHOLIC CHURCH OF FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 519 4th Avenue South, St. Petersburg, FL 33701.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

The purpose of this corporation shall be as follows:

A. To receive and administer funds and to operate exclusively for charitable, religious scientific, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)930 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as the same may be revised from time, including among these purposes, the advancement of those men afflicted with addiction who seek relief and sanctuary.

B. To do such things and perform such acts to accomplish its purposes as the Board of Directors shall deem appropriate and as are not forbidden by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This corporation shall have all the powers conferred on not-for-profit corporations under the laws of the State of Florida, except as provided otherwise in these Articles of Incorporation, provided, however, that notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall not engage in any activity not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE IV

LIMITATIONS

This corporation shall be operated exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, literary or educational purposes as a not-for-profit corporation. No individual director or member of this corporation shall have any title to or interest in the corporate property or earnings in his or her individual or private capacity, and no part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall this corporation participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE V

TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall begin existence upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State, State of Florida, and shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI

INITIAL DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than three (3) persons, who shall be elected, qualified as to their membership, and hold office in accordance with the Bylaws.

The Board of Directors shall be governed by a president, vice president, secretary and treasurer and such other officers as may be established in or permitted by the Bylaws of the corporation.
