ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR IVORY CLUB OF TAMPA, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a nonprofit organization under the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, hereby accepts all the rights, privileges, benefits and obligations conferred and imposed by said law on corporations pursuant to the provisions thereof, and does nereby make, subscribe, certify, acknowledge and file these Articles of incorporation as follows:

ARTCLE 1 - NAME

The name of the organization shall be: IVORY CLUB OF TAMPA, INC.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRES

The Principal place of business and mailing address of the nonprofit corporation shall be: 18404 Millan DeAvilla, Tampa, Florida 33813

ARTICLE III - DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSE

The purposes for which the organization is organized are exclusively charitable, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501 (¢)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1985 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

in the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in section 501 (b)(3) and170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1985 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.

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ARTICLE V - LIMITATION

The organization is not formed for pecuniary profit. No part of the income or assets of the organization is distributable to or for the benefit of its Members, Trustees or Officers, except to the extent permissible under law. The organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services randered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV (Purpose) hereof.

ARTICLE VI - VOTING MEMBERS

The organization shall have voting members who shall be elected (and may be removed) by the voting members and shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the Corporation. The Bylaws may provide for Nonvoting members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have rights and privileges as are set forth in the Bylaws, but who shall not have the right to vote. ARTICLE XIV - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or a state or local government, for a public purpose, Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine. which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
