

ARTICLE ONE Name

The name of the Corporation is PLANT CITY BAR ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE TWO Principal Office and Address

The address of the principal office of the corporation is 212 North Collins Street, Suite 1, Plant City, Florida 33563, and the mailing address of the corporation is P.O. Box 2058, Plant City, Florida 33564.

ARTICLE THREE Duration

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual; and the corporate existence will commence on the filing of these articles by the Department of State.

ARTICLE FOUR Purpose

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are: to uphold the honor and dignity of the legal profession; to promote improvements in the law and its administration; to encourage discourse on legal and civic topics of general interest; to promote the observance of legal ethics; to prevent unauthorized and unethical practice of the law; to cultivate social intercourse among its members; to furnish legal aid to the needy; and to promote a better understanding between the general public and the legal profession.

ARTICLE FIVE Members

The corporation will have members, and the qualifications for membership are set forth in the bylaws of the corporation, except that all active members shall be members in good standing of The Florida Bar. The members are divided into classes, and the rights and limitations for each class are set forth in the bylaws.

ARTICLE SIX Directors

The method of election of Directors of the corporation is set forth in the bylaws.
