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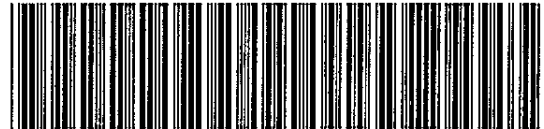

**ARTICLE ONE
Name**

The name of the Corporation is PLANT CITY BAR ASSOCIATION, INC.

**ARTICLE TWO
Principal Office and Address**






