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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FLORIDA ALLIANCE FOR NATURAL HEALTH CARE, INC.

A FLORIDA NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a not for profit corporation, in compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, hereby state:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is: Florida Alliance for Natural Health Care, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The initial street address of the principal office of the corporation is: 215 S. Monroe Street, Suite 701, Tallahassee, FL 32301. The corporation may from time to time move its principal office to another location. The corporation may have such other offices as it deems necessary.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The purpose of the corporation is to:

- A. Promote natural health, wellness, change of lifestyle, good nutrition, and naturopathic medicine as means of acquiring and maintaining good health;
- B. Inform Floridians, through the production of issue advertisements, direct mailings, or such other means as it deems necessary, of public policy issues concerning natural health, wellness, change of lifestyle, good nutrition, and naturopathic medicine as means of acquiring and maintaining good health;
- C. Seek changes to Florida's laws to promote natural health, wellness, change of lifestyle, good nutrition, and naturopathic medicine as means of acquiring and maintaining good health;
- D. Implement such programs to make the public aware of policy issues impacting natural health that are of importance to Floridians;
- E. Do other acts necessary and appropriate to accomplish these purposes, consistent with the requirements of Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(4).

The corporation shall not engage in any business of any kind ordinarily carried on for profit and nothing in these Articles of Incorporation or in the bylaws of the corporation shall authorize the corporation to, and the corporation shall not, enter into any transaction, carry on any activity, or engage in any business for pecuniary profit, any income received by the corporation shall be applied only to the nonprofit purposes and objectives of the corporation

set forth herein and no part thereof during membership or upon termination of membership shall inure to the benefit to the benefit of any private member or individual.

ARTICLE IV - ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The directors of the corporation shall be elected as provided in the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX - CONFLICT OF INTERESTS

In no way directly of indirectly, incidentally or otherwise, shall any part of the earnings of the corporation inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any director or officer of the corporation, or any other private person, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation and to make payment for actual expenditures incurred or for services rendered to or for the benefit of the corporation and to make payments and distributions for the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

ARTICLE X – DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

In the event of the dissolution or final liquidation of the corporation, all of the remaining assets and property of the corporation shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities and obligations of the corporation and for necessary expenses thereof, be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code as determined by the directors for the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. In no event shall any of such assets or property be distributed to any officer or director of the corporation or to any private individual.
