

### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COORDINATING COUNCIL, IN

FIRST: The name of this corporation is:

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COORDINATING COUNCIL, IS

SECOND: The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COORDINATING COUNCIL, INC. c/o Refuge House P.O. Box 20910 Tallahassee, FL 32316

THIRD: This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and other non-profitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law). The DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COORDINATING COUNCIL, INC. is a non-profit, non-residential, community-based program established to promote zero tolerance of domestic violence in our community through education, prevention, and accessible, coordinated intervention strategies focused on victim safety and offender accountability. To promote this primary purpose, the corporation's objectives shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

(a) to provide community-based education on the dynamics of
domestic violence to begin a community-wide transformation that

results ultimately in zero tolerance toward domestic violence and support for victims of domestic violence.

(b) to increase inter-agency collaboration, coordination, and communication, resulting in improved service delivery by providing community-wide interventions that hold batterers accountable and promote victim safety and autonomy.

The corporation shall be empowered and authorized to do any and all things which corporations not-for-profit are authorized to do under the laws of the State of Florida; provided, however, that the corporation shall not carry on activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law). No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and disbursements in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Third Article.

FOURTH: The officers and Board of Directors shall be elected annually by a majority of the Council's member agencies using written ballots at a regularly scheduled meeting at which a quorum is present.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

<u>NINTH</u>: The Council will not, as a substantial part of its activities, attempt to influence legislation or participate to any extent in a political campaign for or against any candidate for public office.

TENTH: No officer or director of the corporation shall have any ownership or proprietary interest in the capital, surplus, assets or property of the corporation. In the event of liquidation, dissolution, or winding up, whether by voluntary act, bankruptcy or other judicial proceeding, all capital, surplus, property, assets and funds of the corporation remaining after paying all of its debts and obligations shall be disposed of exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or shall be conveyed, transferred and paid over to such other not-for-profit corporation or corporations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific

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Sections 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United State Internal Revenue law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court for Leon County, Florida, in the exercise of the court's equity jurisdiction over charitable trusts, preference being given, so far as is practicable and permissible, to an organization which is organized and operated for purposes similar to
