ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I: NAME OF CORPORATION: The name of the Corporation is The Intertribal Cultural Arts Society Inc.

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE: The principal office of the corporation is located at 699 N. Hwy 301 Sumterville Fl 33585

ARTICLE III: MAILING ADDRESS: The mailing address of the corporation is PO Box 490799 Leesburg Fl 34479-34749

ARTICLE IV: REGISTERED AGENT: The registered agent for the corporation is Thomas Lipps. The address of this registered agent is 699 N. Hwy 301 Sumterville Fl 33585

ARTICLE V: DURATION/MEMBERSHIP: The period of duration is perpetual, starting November 1 2003. The qualification for members, if any, and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the bylaws.

ARTICLE VII : CORPORATE PURPOSES:

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are exclusively charitable and educational and consist of the following:

- 1. To educate the general public about the specific and general aspects of cultural heritage of any and all Native American tribes and/or Nations, existing or extinct, that the knowledge of the heritage handed down from antiquity, i.e., "the old ways", be not lost to memory, to raise the knowledge level of those of Native American heritage about their arts and culture, to foster and promote community wide concern for the retention of the culture and heritage of said tribes and/or Nations, to expand the general public awareness of the social and cultural interaction necessary to eliminate racial tensions, prejudice, and discrimination, economic and otherwise.
- 2. To aid, support, and assist by gifts, contributions, or otherwise, other societies, foundations, councils that are organized and operated for charitable, and educational purposes, no part of the net earnings of which inures to the benefit of any private individual, and no substantial part of the activities of

which is carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.

- 3. To do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, or desirable for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering, or attaining of the foregoing purposes, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction or cooperation with others, whether such others be persons or organizations of any kind or nature, such as corporations, firms, association, trusts, institution, councils, foundations, or governmental bureaus, departments or agencies.
- 4. All of the foregoing purposes shall be exercised exclusively charitable and educational purposes in such a manner that the Corporation will qualify as an exempt organization under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE VIII: 501 (C) (3) LIMITATIONS

- 1. CORPORATE PURPOSES: Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal and state income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- 2. EXCLUSIVITY: The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.
- 3. NO PRIVATE INUREMENT: The Corporation is not organized nor shall it be operated for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit. The Corporation shall not distribute any gains, profits or dividends to the Directors or Officer thereof, or to any individual, except as reasonable compensation for services actually performed in carrying out the Corporation's charitable and educational purposes. The property, assets, profits and net income of the Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes no part of which shall inure to the benefit of any individual.
- 4. LOBBYING AND POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS: No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 5. DISSOLUTION: Upon winding up and dissolution of the corporation, the assets of the Corporation remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to an organization recognized as exempt under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to be used exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. If the corporation holds any assets in trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by decree of the Circuit Court of the district in which the Corporation's principal office is located, upon petition thereof by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.
