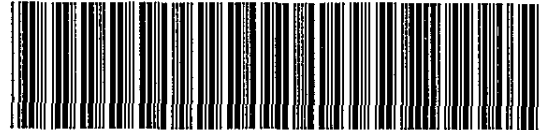

We, the undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person, competent to contract, hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file these Articles for the purpose of becoming a Corporation not for profit pursuant to Chapter 617.0202, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Tampa Coalition for Change, Inc.

ARTICLE II: PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business shall be in the County of Hillsborough, State of Florida as determined by the Board of Directors. The mailing address is: P.O. Box 310364-Tampa, Florida-33680-0364.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

The lawful purpose for which this corporation not for profit is organized is as follows:

1. To increase the number of registered African-American voters.
2. To increase participation of African-American voters in the electoral process through voter education.
3. To recruit, encourage, and support qualified culturally diverse candidates for elective office.
4. To ensure that all governmental resources are equitably allocated in all communities.

5. To be more politically astute and socially savvy in the economic, political and social culture of the Tampa Bay area.

ARTICLE IV: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than five(5) individuals from the community.

The Board of Directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the directors and each directors shall hold office for a term determined by the board of directors and until his or her successor is duly elected and qualified or until his or her death, resignation or removal from office.

Each person named in the Articles of Incorporation as a member of the initial Board of Directors shall hold office for an initial term of two (2) years and until his or her successor have been elected and qualified or until his or her death, resignation, or removal from office.

or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.


