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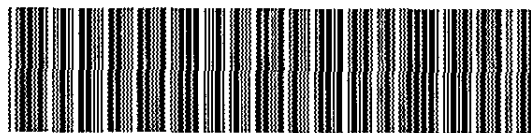

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
VOLUSIA EDUCATION ADVOCATES INC.

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of the corporation shall be
VOLUSIA EDUCATION ADVOCATES INC.

ARTICLE 11

ARTICLE 111

Purpose

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The corporation is created pursuant to the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes and dedicated to advancing the knowledge, scientific research, and the educational opportunities for children who are mentally, emotionally or physically challenged.

ARTICLE 1V

ARTICLE V

Earnings and Limitations of Activities

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE VI

Distribution of Assets

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VII

Manner of Election of Officers

The manner by which directors are elected will be stated in the bylaws.
