ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

The Children's Golf Foundation of Miami Springs, ADCAHASSEE, FLORIDA
(A Florida Corporation, Not For Profit)

We, the undersigned, hereby form ourselves and our successors into a corporation not for profit under the corporate name of **The Children's Golf Foundation of Miami Springs**, **Inc.**, and hereby adopt the following articles of incoporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation is **The Children's Golf Foundation of Miami Springs, Inc.** (hereinafter called the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II

The street address of the initial principal office and the mailing address of the Corporation shall be: 121 Morningside Drive, #3, Miami Springs, Florida 33166.

ARTICLE III

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is:

- (a) To build, erect, lease, maintain, equip, manage and operate athletic facilities at or near the City of Miami Springs, Miami-Dade County, Florida, including, but not limited to a golf course facility, for the rehabilitation and/or recreation of the physically disabled and/or financially handicapped or deprived children; and to do all things necessary to promote, manage and operate such athletic facilities for the good and well-being and welfare of such children, including, but not limited to providing such other facilities in support thereof and employing such personnel who are necessary for the proper administration of such athletic facilities and the operation thereof.
- (b) To promote the game and sport of golf for the benefit of such physically disabled and/or financially handicapped and/or deprived children.
- (c) To assist the aforesaid children without regard to their race, creed, color.
- (d) To receive, administer, disburse and invest gifts, devises and bequests by or from any person or corporation for the promotion of the above purposes.
- (e) To buy, sell, lease, build, construct, erect, maintain and equip offices or buildings to carry out the above purposes, and to issue bonds, notes, debentures and evidences of indebtedness and to secure the same by mortgage, security agreement, deed of trust or otherwise.
- (f) The corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Not-withstanding any other

provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (I) from a corporation exempt from Federal Income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, (or the corresponding provision of any future United Stated Internal Revenue Law), or (II) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United Sates Internal Revenue law).

ARTICLE IV

Management of the Corporation shall be vested in the Corporation's Board of Directors, the members of which shall be not less than three. The number and method of election of the directors of the Corporation who shall serve following the terms of the initial directors of the Corporation shall be as stated in the bylaws; except that the third member of the first Board of Directors will be appointed by the incorporator of this corporation prior to the initial meeting of said Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V

The term for which this Corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI

The Bylaws of this corporation shall be made, altered or amended, by a majority vote of the Board of Directors of the Corporation, at any regular or special meeting duly and regularly called by the Board or any Director.

ARTICLE VII

Upon written or oral notice, the Articles of Incorporation may be amended, altered, or rescinded by a four-fifth vote of the Board of Directors of the Corporation, in accordance with procedures established by the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII
