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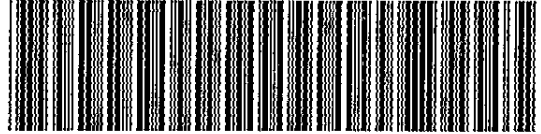

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
GODIS, INC.**

Article 1 – Name

The name of this corporation is GODIS, INC.

Article 2 – Duration

This corporation shall exist perpetually commencing on the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State.

Article 3 – Purpose

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

1. To provide programs, travel/cultural experiences and athletic activities aimed to help youth improve their quality of life through the building of self-esteem and development of values critical to growth/maturity.
2. To contribute positively to the community and environment of the areas it serves, whether local, state, national or international.
3. To provide an opportunity for self-development of adolescents/teenagers.
4. To provide an opportunity for contact between business/community leaders to enhance the development of participants public programs.
5. To purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise or bequest, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use or otherwise deal in or with real and personal property or any interest therein, wherever situate.
6. To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer or otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.
7. Any other lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit.
8. The above stated purposes shall be within the meaning of charitable, educational and other purposes as defined in Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

This Corporation may have Members. Members of this corporation will be required to meet qualifications and will be admitted pursuant to the Bylaws.


Article 9 – ByLaws




