ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

ONE:

The name of the corporation is Kingdom Resource and Development, Inc. The address for the initial registered office is 7313 Rolling Hills Road, Pensacola, Florida 325. The corporation is organized pursuant to the State of Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code.

TWO:

This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The corporation is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable and educational purposes to aid the poor and disadvantaged individuals and families towards a life of self-sufficiency. The programs will consist of but shall not be limited to: (1) Establishing a domestic satellite office in the state of Florida to carry out the programs of Kingdom Resource and Development, Inc., a 501 (c) (3) tax-exempt organization in the state of Alabama (2) To provide Faith Based and Non-Profit Organization Referrals and Outreach Programs, Job Training, Job Placement, Land Acquisition, Housing, Temporary Shelter, Substance Abuse Awareness and Prevention, Tutoring, Health, Counseling, and other programs to aid those in need.

THREE:

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, no stock and shall have no members.

FIVE:

- (a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for Educational and Charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

SIX:

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to Charitable and Educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or the benefit of any private person.

SEVEN:

On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for, Educational and Charitable under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such asset not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is located, exclusive for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

EIGHT:

The Directors are elected in accordance with the Bylaws. A Director must be at least 18 years of age. The number of Directors shall be three (3).
