A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

Article 1. Name The name of the Corporation is BARNABAS CHRISTIAN CHURCH, INCORPORATED.

Article 2. Duration The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

Article 3. Purposes. The purpose of the Corporation is as follows:

- A. This corporation is a non-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statues. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purpose of this corporation is to help hurting and discouraged people find hope through God's only hope for man, which is Jesus Christ.
- B. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
- C. Provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under Internal Revenue Code and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefits of or be distributable to its members, directors, or officers; but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation to these people for services rendered, and to make payment and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes.

Article 4. Members. The Corporation shall have Voting Members, who shall be elected (and may be removed) by the Voting Members, ad who shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the Corporation. The Bylaws may provide for Nonvoting Members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have such rights and privileges as are set forth in the Bylaws, but who shall not have the right to vote.
