ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

<u>OF</u>

MARIANNA ARTS FESTIVAL, INCORPORATED

A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, being natural persons, competent to contract, hereby form this corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is: Marianna Arts Festival, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II NATURE OF BUSINESS

This is a non-profit corporation organized solely for general charitable purposes pursuant to the Florida Not for Profit Corporation law set forth in Chapter 617, of the Florida Statutes.

GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSE

(A) The specific and primary purposes for which the corporation is organized is to create an active interest and to foster active participation and experiences in the Arts to help people learn and grow. The Arts helps individuals increase educational achievement and lead to career success. The Arts which are an integral part of our young people's education progress; to promote, support, and create active interest in the Arts among parents, students,

and the community at large.

- (B) The general purposes for which the corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for such purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as amended, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as tax-exempt organizations under that Code.
- (C) This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV

TERM OF EXISTENCE

The existence of the Corporation shall begin on the day the Articles of Incorporation are filed with the Secretary of State. The corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE V MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall have membership distinct from the board of trustees. The authorized number and qualification of the members of the corporation, the manner of their admission, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be set forth in the bylaws.

Annual meetings shall be held at the hour of 7:00 p.m., on the first Monday of each year at the principal office of the corporation or at such other place or places as the board of trustees may designate from time to time by resolution.

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the board of trustees under any provision of the law may be taken without a meeting, if all members of the board shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the board, and any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as if taken by unanimous vote of the trustees. Any certificate or other documents filed under any provision of law which relates to action so taken shall state that the action was taken by a unanimous written consent of the board of trustees without a meeting and that the articles of incorporation (and bylaws) of the corporation authorize the trustees to so act. Such a statement shall be prima facie evidence of such authority.

ARTICLE XI DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, or all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational or charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE XII AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES

Amendments to these articles of incorporation may be proposed by a resolution adopted by the board of trustees and presented to a quorum of members for their vote. Amendments may be adopted by the vote of two-thirds of a quorum of members of the corporation.
