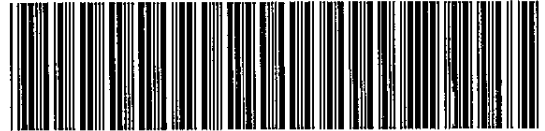

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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
Of
PANHANDLE AREA DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE PREVENTION COALITION INC.**

**ARTICLE I
CORPORATION NAME**

The name of this Florida not-for-profit corporation is: **Panhandle Area Drug and Alcohol Abuse Prevention Coalition Inc.**

**ARTICLE II
PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS**

The corporation's principal place of business is located at Marianna, Florida. The corporation's mailing address is: 2863 Green Street, Suite 2-B, Marianna, Florida 32448.

**ARTICLE III
CORPORATE PURPOSE**

The purpose of the corporation is to assess community needs, develop strategic plans, seek funding, train members in coalition building, and to educate and inform the community about substance abuse problems, risks and protective factors, and the best practices, which can be applied to prevent and reduce drug and alcohol abuse in Calhoun, Holmes, Jackson, Liberty and Washington Counties. The Coalition is specifically precluded from providing direct substance abuse treatment services.

The Corporation intends to be organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code) and relevant Florida law. Specifically, the Corporation is organized for any and all of the following purposes: conducting scientific research and research projects in the public interest in the fields of public health, behavioral health, and related areas; improving and developing the abilities of individuals and institutions studying, teaching and practicing behavioral health; delivering behavioral health care to the public; engaging in the instruction of the general public and community organizations and institutions in the area of public health and behavioral health, and related instruction useful to the individual and beneficial to the community; and conducting other activities useful or appropriate to the accomplishment of the foregoing purposes.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall the Corporation participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. The Corporation shall not have objectives that characterize it as an "action organization" as defined by the Internal Revenue Code and related regulations, rulings and procedures.

Notwithstanding any other provision in these Articles, the Corporation shall not engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax codes; or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code.

The Corporation shall not carry on an unrelated trade or business except as a secondary purpose related to the Corporation's primary exempt purposes.

ARTICLE IV **MEMBERS**

PANDAAP shall be made up of 15 to 25 multi-cultural and multi-racial members from organizations throughout the five county service area that represent child care, law enforcement, schools, HIV/AIDS prevention, domestic violence, local business, local colleges, the faith-based community, juvenile and child welfare agencies, county health departments, local government, civic and advocacy organizations, and any concerned citizen wishing to participate in the Coalition.

The Coalition may from time to time establish additional types of members and/or conditions for membership, according to the process described for Coalition voting in the Coalition Bylaws. The initial Members of the Corporation shall be:

ARTICLE VIII
DISSOLUTION

ARTICLE IX
DISTRIBUTION LIMITATIONS

Subject to all relevant laws, no dividends shall be declared, and no part of the income, profit or net earnings of the Corporation shall at any time be paid directly or indirectly to any person or entity in violation of the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act or such other relevant laws. The Corporation is and shall be authorized to confer benefits and to make such necessary and appropriate distributions in conformity with relevant Florida law and the purposes of the Corporation.
