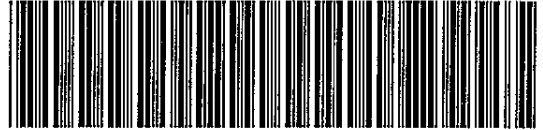

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not-for-Profit Research Corporation)

ARTICLE I - NAME

Name: The name of the corporation shall be: Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc.

ARTICLE II – PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this not for profit research corporation shall be: 8799 Bardmoor Boulevard, Suite 201, Largo, Florida 33777

ARTICLE III – PURPOSES

Bayesian analysis implies the exploitation of a suitable prior information about the parameters involved and the choice of a loss function in association with Bayes' theorem. It rests on the notion that a parameter within a failure model is not merely an unknown quantity, but rather behaves as a random variable, which follows some distribution. In the area of life testing, it is indeed realistic to assume that a life parameter is stochastically dynamic.

Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. puts an emphasis on the strategic application of knowledge, approaches and techniques that will serve as foundation for improved implementation in academia and industry.

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

1. to create innovative approaches to improving classical methods in statistics and to solving real world problems.
2. to promote collaboration between researchers, practitioners, universities, federal and state governments, and industries.
3. to render services to universities, industries, practitioners, researchers, government and non-profit sectors through dissemination of knowledge and results by means of publications, presentations and other appropriate methods.
4. to foster the integration of research and education by providing instrumentation for research learning environments.

ARTICLE IV – MANNER OF ELECTION

4.1 Board of Directors: The corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall elect a President, a Vice-President, a Treasurer, a Secretary, and other such officers, if any, as the Board of Directors shall deem appropriate. An officer, chosen with advice of the Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. board, shall be elected for a two (2) or three (3) year term, and until her/his successor shall be elected and shall qualify to serve.

4.2 Executive Director: The Executive Director shall be appointed by the Board of Directors and shall be the chief administrative officer of the corporation. His/ her duties include:

- 4.2.1 Leading the Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. board, encouraging its committees to fulfill their tasks, scheduling Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. board meetings,
- 4.2.2 Developing Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. strategies, policies, goals and overall operation plan.
- 4.2.3 Implementing the above mentioned strategies, policies, goals and plans.
- 4.2.4 Managing Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. and its activities, including financial matters.
- 4.2.5 Identifying and recommending to the Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. board the best-qualified member involved in the activities of Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc..
- 4.2.6 Assuming evaluation of Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. sponsored research.
- 4.2.7 Networking with universities, nonprofit organizations, etc....

4.3 Associate Directors: The Associate Directors are appointed. The Associate Directors will be responsible for:

- 4.3.1 Assisting the Director in the developing of policies, goals, strategies, overall operating plans and schedules related to Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. objectives.
- 4.3.2 Developing and coordinating Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. activities with universities, businesses and nonprofit organizations.
- 4.3.3 Conducting research in his/her area, maintaining professional memberships and attending relevant conferences.
- 4.3.4 Accountable for reporting on revenues and expenses
- 4.3.5 Supervising the support staff as they perform work in accordance with established Research Center for Bayesian Applications, Inc. processes.
- 4.3.6 Attending relevant conferences.
