PLAN OF LIQUIDATION, DISSOLUTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

This Plan of Liquidation, Dissolution and Distribution of Assets of JOSEPH CASTELLANO VALENTI, JR. FOUNDATION, INC., a Florida Not-For-profit Corporation (called "Corporation"), adopted this 1974 day of ________, 1996.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Directors and Members of the Corporation deem it advisable to liquidate and dissolve the Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Corporation shall be liquidated and dissolved and its assets distributed as follows:

- 1. This plan shall become effective upon approval by the Members and Directors of the Corporation, by written consent, in compliance with Sections 617.1402, 617.1406, 617.0701 and 617.0821 of the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act.
- 2. Upon adoption of this Plan, the officers of the Corporation shall proceed with a voluntary dissolution of the Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.
- 3. The Corporation shall cease conducting its affairs, shall wind up its affairs and shall completely liquidate within the meaning of and in accordance with Sections 617.1405 and 617.1406 of the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act.
- 4. The officers of the Corporation are hereby authorized and directed to pay and discharge all liabilities and obligations of the Corporation, or make adequate provision therefor, in accordance with Florida Statutes Section 617.1406.
- 5. The officers of the Corporation are hereby authorized to distribute to The Children's Home, Inc, 10909 Memorial Highway, Tampa, Florida 33615, an organization exempt from Florida income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, in accordance with Florida Statute Section 617.1406, any and all remaining assets of the Corporation, less such assets as in the judgment of the Directors and officers of the Corporation should be

retained to satisfy all debts, fees, expenses and liabilities of the Corporation. Any and all assets not used for the payment of the Corporation's liabilities and obligations shall be distributed to the Children's Home, Inc.

- 6. Within the time required by law, the officers shall cause to be filed final Form 990-PF with the appropriate District Director of Internal Revenue.
- 7. In order to carry out this Plan, the officers are hereby authorized to execute, deliver and/or file any and all documents and to take any and all actions which the officers deem necessary or advisable.
- 8. The officers, Directors and Members, and each of them, are hereby indemnified and held harmless from all claims, expenses and liabilities resulting from any action taken in good faith in carrying out this Plan.
