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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statues, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

<u>ARTICLE I</u>

ARTICLE II

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ARTICLE III

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Purposes include religious, charitable, benevolent, scientific and educational activities, especially to conduct religious services, to cultivate social activities among its members and to assist in improving the moral and spiritual conditions of humanity.

To purchase and sell such literature, including magazines, pamphlets, and books as in the opinion of the Council and the Minister would be for the furtherance of its purposes and causes.

To receive love offerings and contributions; to receive, manage, take and hold real, personal or other property by gift, grant, devise or bequest and to sell or dispose of the same for the benefit of this corporation.

To purchase or sell, mortgage, and lease such real and personal property as may be necessary for purpose of the corporation, and to execute deeds, contract agreements and obligations, the purposes whereof are consistent with the laws of the state of Florida under which this corporation is formed, and to accept and execute any trust, the purpose whereof is lawful under said laws and consistent with the

accomplishment of any of the purposes herein named, or which may at any time appear conducive or expedient for the benefit or protection of this corporation.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall benefit any member, officer, director, or incorporator of the corporation, but the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except to the extent permitted by the Code), and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall have all the powers to carry out any and all activities in furtherance of any purpose for which a corporation may be organized, except to the extent that any power or purpose would not be permitted to be carried on:

- (1) by an organization exempt from Federal income taxation under Section 501 (a) of the Code, or the corresponding provision of any future Federal income tax law, by reason of being described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Code;
- (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (a) of the Code by reason of such corporation being described in Section 170 (c) (2) of the Code.

ARTICLE IV

Upon winding up and dissolution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporation remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to an organization recognized as exempt under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to be used exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.

ARTICLE V

Any person (and the heirs, executors, and administrators of such person) made or threaten to be made a party to any action, suit of proceeding by reason of the fact that he is or was a Director or Officer of the Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation against any and all liability and the reasonable expenses incurred by him or his heirs.

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

An election committee makes nominations from the church membership for the directors of the church. Directors are chosen from the nominees by the voting members of the church.
