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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION for

We, the undersigned natural persons all being of the age of eighteen years or more, acting as incorporators under the Chapter 617, F.S., adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article I: Name

The name of the corporation shall be 3 Dimension Entertainment Group, Incorporated.

Article II: Principal Office

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

Article III: Purpose

- 1. To act and operate exclusively as a nonprofit corporation with charitable and educational emphasis pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida for the purpose of:
 - a. Promoting academics, cultural and fine arts and increase social awareness among school aged youth from various socioeconomic backgrounds and geographic through long- and short-term programs and workshops designed to educate as well as entertain.
 - b. To solicit and receive contributions, purchase, own and sell real and personal property, to make contracts, to invest corporate funds, to spend corporate funds for corporate purposes, and to engage in any activity in furtherance of, incidental to, or connected with any of the foregoing and following purposes:
 - i. Maintain and create youth programs for the purposes stated in Article III-1.a.
 - ii. Establish and maintain enough funding to provide education assistance to youth affiliated with any of the programs of the corporation.
 - c. Encourage civic involvement of youth through community service.
 - d. Provide outlets for youth participating in the long- or short-term programs to display mastery of skills they have learned as a result of the training and instruction received as participants of these programs.

- 2. To engage in any and all activities and pursuits, and to support this company and its programs or assist such other organizations, as may be reasonably related to this company's purpose as outlined in Article III-1.
- 3. To engage in any and all other lawful purposes, activities and pursuits, which are substantially similar to the foregoing and which are or may hereafter be authorized by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and are consistent with those powers described in the Chapter 617, F.S., as amended and supplemented.

Article IV: Manner of Election

This corporation shall have a least three members on the Board of Directors pursuant to Chapter 617, F.S. and be appointed by the President and Vice-President of the corporation.

Article VIII: Distributions

- 1. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to the corporation and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein.
- 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in , or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office except as authorized under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.
- 3. The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended or supplemented.

Article IX: Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended or supplemented, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
