ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be TABERNACIE

The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than three persons and not more than fifteen persons, who shall we elected annually by the members of the congregation of the labornacle Baytist Church of Mismi, Florida, as provided in the by-ways of this corporation.
