T.

The name of this corporation is The Haitian-American Institute for Democracy and Development, Inc..

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The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.

III.

The general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted by said corporation shall be as follows:

The Institute is an independent, non-partisan institution dedicated to advancing democracy and promoting development in Haiti. The institute gathers and disseminates information about Haiti and Haitians to the media, other agencies and the international community. The Institute also assist the people of Haiti through education outreach and humanitarian programs. The Institute's activities will also include those of a charitable, educational, social service, public service, humanitarian, and economic development nature. Participants in Institute programs, projects, and activities will include Haitian-Americans residing in the United States, friends of the Haitian people in the United States, and supporters of the institute's objectives from throughout the world. The Institute may also engage in any and all other activities that would be proper and lawful under any and all applicable laws, regulations, and treaties, and will have, exercise, and enjoy the powers and privileges granted to corporations not for profit by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

Further, the Institute shall be empowered to do everything necessary, suitable, and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, of the attainment of any of the objects,

or for the furtherance of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things, incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid business or powers, or any part thereof; provided, that the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

The purposes for which The Haitian-American Institute for Democracy and Development, Inc. is organized are exclusively pubic service, developmental, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

IV.

Officers/Directors shall be qualified for admission, and shall be admitted as Officers/Directors, in accordance with the by-laws of this corporation; a two-thirds vote of the membership shall be required for the election of new Officers/Directors or for the removal of current directors.

V.
