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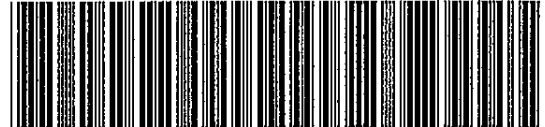

## Articles of Incorporation

FILED

**ARTICLE I: NAME:** The name of this corporation is: **Escambia County Sheriff's Office Police Athletic League (PAL), Inc.**

**ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE:** The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation is: 6065 South Gulf Manor, Pensacola, Florida 32526-1568, Escambia County.

**ARTICLE III: PURPOSE:** This corporation is organized pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person.

A. The purposes for which this corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. This will provide an outlet for growth and development in the area of self discipline through organized team sports of choice. Target populations will include but not limited to "At Risk" youth (for example: abused, disadvantaged troubled youngsters and their families). The programs may also consist of and/or provide counseling in: **Employment, Permanent Housing, Temporary Shelter, Teen-Age Pregnancy, Substance Abuse, Recovery and Rehabilitation, Mentoring, Educational and Computer Tutoring, Food, Clothing, Job Training, Land Acquisition, After School Activities and other Programs appropriate to the cause of aiding those in need.**

B. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

C. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, State, or Local Government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of, shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

**ARTICLE IV: MANNER OF ELECTION:** Directors of this organization will be nominated and selected by a majority vote of attendees at the General Meeting. Vacancies created by unforeseen circumstances, such as death, resignation or dismissal, will be filled on a temporary basis by appointments made by the Board of Directors. These temporary appointments will exist until the next Annual or Special Meeting, duly called by the Board of Directors.

**ARTICLE V: INITIAL DIRECTORS:** The number of directors that constitute the initial board of directors is **twenty-two (22)**. The names, address and titles of personnel selected as the initial directors of this corporation are:
