ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE AMERICAN LEGION POST 109 OF OCOEE, INC.



ARTICLE I - NAME and PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of this corporation is THE AMERICAN LEGION POST 109 OF OCOEE, INC. and its principal place of business shall be located at 1701 Adair Street, Ococe, Florida 34761

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of this filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State.

ARTICLE III - NONPROFIT PURPOSES

This corporation is organized for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

- (A) The purposes for which The American Legion Post 109 of Ocoee, Inc. is organized are exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- (B) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- (C) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
- (D) To solicit, collect and otherwise raise money to fund those aims and goals of The American Legion 109 of Ocoee, Inc. which are exclusively charitable and within the
