Articles of Incorporation Of

HAITIAN STUDENTS FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE ONE.

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: Haitian Students Foundation, Inc (hereiffafter called the corporation).

ARTICLE TWO. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business of the corporation shall be: 1784 N Congress Aveste. 103 – West Palm Beach– Florida 33409 and the mailing address shall be P.O. Box 7507 – Lake Worth – Florida 33466 unless otherwise established by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE THREE. PURPOSES

The corporation is primarily formed to operate exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or such other provisions of any subsequent state or/and federal tax laws. The corporation will assist Haitian students pursue post secondary education. It shall not engage in any form of propaganda or political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Earnings of the corporation shall not inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, officers and directors except that it shall be empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose herein set forth.

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE FOUR. MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which directors are elected or appointed following the term of the initial board will be determined by the constitution or bylaws.
